HABC Level 2 Award in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillation (QCF)

This accredited qualification is ideal for learners who require further training or wish to develop knowledge and/or skills in this subject area. It is suitable for first aiders in the workplace environment who have access to a defibrillator. The qualification maintains good practice in the safe, prompt and effective administration of cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillation. Subjects covered include basic life support and safe use of a defibrillator.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

This qualification is usually achieved by taking a one-day course.

How is the qualification assessed?

This can be done by either of the following two options:

Option 1 – Multiple-Choice Assessment

Learners must answer a series of multiple-choice questions across the breadth of the course syllabus within a specific time frame.

Option 2 - Open Response Assessment

Learners must provide a short response to questions across the breadth of the course syllabus throughout the duration of the course.
