HABC Level 2 Award in Paediatric First Aid (QCF)

This accredited qualification is ideal for those who wish to become a Paediatric First Aider in the workplace with a responsibility for the welfare of infants and children. The qualification maintains good practice in the safe, prompt and effective treatment of injuries and ill health of infants and children who are under the care of trained personnel. Subjects covered include the role of the paediatric first aider, assessment and procedures for emergency situations, procedures for infant and child first aid including shock, wounds and bleeding, and breathing difficulties.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

This qualification is usually achieved by taking a 2 day course.

How is the qualification assessed?

The qualification is assessed via practical demonstration and oral questioning throughout the course along with a 15-question multiple-choice examination at the end.
